




Workshop for professionals working in the field of International Cooperation (IC), at headquarters or in the field. Participants are encouraged to attend with 1–2 other team members.

 - Are consultants to multicultural teams

- Objectives** By the end of the workshop, participants will have:
- Deepened their understanding of the challenges and opportunities of multicultural team membership or leadership in a context of International Cooperation
 - Become aware of the extent to which their own «practice» of team membership or leadership influences the success of multicultural teamwork
 - Developed their skills for remaining focused and effective in the midst of team challenge and uncertainty
 - Gained new perspectives for creating a team culture in which every member can contribute his/her best, in terms of skills and cultural patterns

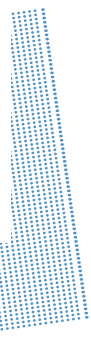
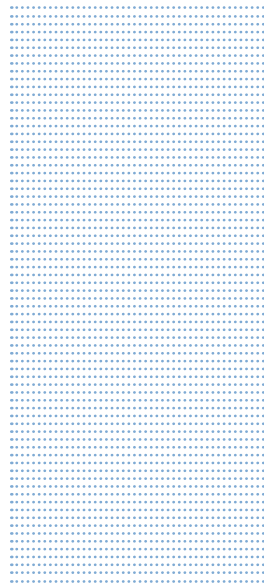
