

## Internship opportunities at the Asian Development Bank

### Internship Programme

---

<b>Particularity</b>	The internship programme is a project-oriented learning opportunity for graduate students to gain experience through research assignments based on ADB's current operational needs.
<b>Duration</b>	8 weeks – 6 months
<b>Duty station</b>	HQ or field office
<b>Age</b>	No age limit
<b>Academic requirements</b>	Currently enrolled in a Master's- or PhD-level programme at a school in one of the ADB member nations (incl. Switzerland), with plans to return to school after internship.
<b>Professional experience required</b>	Some relevant professional experience
<b>Language requirements</b>	Proficiency in English
<b>Compensation</b>	Stipend is provided according to the location up to 8 weeks. After 8 weeks, no stipend is provided to interns. ADB may additionally cover a part of the airfare travel cost and food expenses.
<b>Available positions</b>	Approx. 30 positions per year
<b>Number of applicants per vacancy</b>	Approx. 100–150 applicants per vacancy
<b>Application dates and intakes</b>	Two intakes per year: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Applications accepted in January/February for intake in early summer</li><li>2. Applications accepted in August/September for intake in winter</li></ol>
